Office Paper

- Computer and notebook paper
- Index cards

Mixed Paper

- Newspaper
- Boxboard
- Coffee cups (empty)
- Magazines

Plastic

- Water bottles
- Tubs, cups or food trays (rinse clean)
- Milk jugs
- Plastic bags

Household Metal

- Cans
- Foil
- Jar lids

Cardboard

- Boxes

Glass (all colors)

- Bottles
- Jars
